




## EN Parts



1.2 m MDF strips (63 mm x 9 mm) x6

**NOTE:** Contents of 1 pack covers approximately 1.2 sqm. You will need to add multiple packs together if you require to cover a larger area.

## EN Safety

### Before you start

- The surface should be free of all dust and debris and loose material.
- To prepare the wall surface, remove any flaking plaster or peeling paint with a scraper or medium-grit sandpaper. Use a cloth to remove any dust or debris.
- Contents of 1 pack covers approximately 1.2 sqm. You will need to add multiple packs together if you require to cover a larger area.

### Safety

- When preparing your walls and installing the wall panelling, you should keep the room you are working in as ventilated as possible. Wear an appropriate mask when sanding and wear safety goggles for eye protection when using machine tools.

### Guarantee

We take special care to select high quality materials and use manufacturing techniques that allow us to create products incorporating design and durability. 



**EN** Measure the wall length to be panelled. Depending on the measurement, cut one or more strips to length to make up horizontal strip across the top of skirting. Apply adhesive in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and press strip(s) to the wall.

## 02




**EN** Calculate the distance between vertical strips using the method described below (it can be used for any wall length).

1. Subtract the width of a single strip from wall length.  
i.e. for 1800mm wall length subtract strip width 63 mm:  $1800 - 63 = 1737$  mm
2. Divide the result by desired number of panels (recessed areas between 2 strips).  
i.e. for 3 panels  $1737 \text{ mm} / 3 = 579$  mm
3. Finally, for the distance between vertical strips subtract the width of a single strip.  
 $579 - 63 = 516$  mm

Mark it up as shown for next steps.


## 03



**EN** For a recessed square panel effect, copy the distance calculated in previous step for horizontal panel strips.

Measure and mark up as shown, depending on how many panels up.  
i.e. if 2 panels up, mark up the calculated (516 mm) distance between horizontal strips twice as shown.

## 04




**EN** Cut one or more strips to measured length to make up remaining horizontal strips.

Check with spirit level, apply adhesive and press strip(s) to the wall.

The horizontal strips can be now used as guide for vertical strips.

## 05




**EN** The length calculated in Step 02 (516 mm in the example) is the length vertical strips need to be cut to.

Apply adhesive on cut to length vertical strip and press to the wall.

Repeat steps for all vertical strips to create recessed square panelling effect as shown.

## 06



**EN** Fill any gaps and joints with decorator's caulk. Wipe off any excess and sand for a smooth finish if required.

You are now ready to paint.
