- Keep a close check on any cables that are being used especially extension cables. If they appear to be damaged in any way, stop the generator and replace them.
- 2. The generator has fuses or circuit breakers to protect it in case of overload. If a fuse appears to have blown, ensure a competent person replaces it.
- The generator may switch itself off if it gets too hot. Allow it to cool down before 3. restarting. If this happens repeatedly, check with a competent person or the hire
- Stop the generator before leaving it unattended. 4.
- If the equipment does not work properly, do not attempt to repair it. Contact the 5 hire company.




