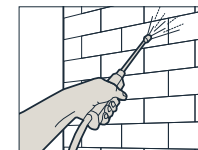
Prepare

Tools you'll need:

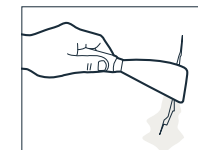
- Masking tape
- Dust sheets
- Stiff bristle brush
- Filling knife
- Exterior filler
- Primer
- Stabiliser
- Fungicidal wash



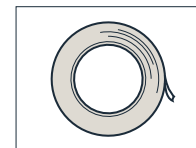
1
Take a stiff bristle brush to remove loose dirt



2
Clean the walls with fungicidal wash



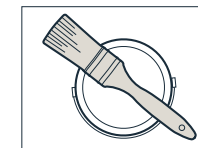
3
Fill any holes and cracks



4
Put masking tape on your windowsills to protect them from paint splashes



5
Use a masonry primer or stabilising solution on difficult surfaces



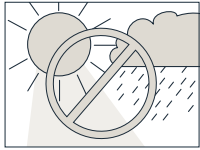

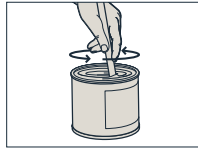
Paint

Tools you'll need:

- Masonry brush
- Masonry roller
- Ladder
- Extension poles



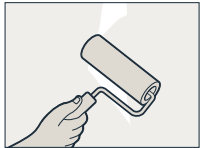
1
Avoid painting in extreme weather conditions



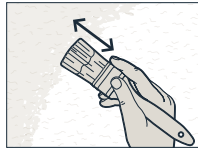
2
Stir the paint before use



3
Apply the loaded brush to an unpainted area, and work your way back to a painted area. Paint in several directions to ensure the surface is completely covered



4
If using a roller, vary the angle of your strokes. Use a brush to get into the corners and around obstructions



5
On rough surfaces, rotate the brush in all directions, dabbing the bristles into the surface with a stippling action, to ensure you've covered everything evenly



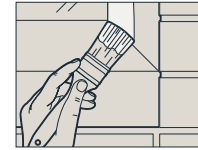
6
For added protection and longer life in difficult areas, apply more coats of paint. Leave 4 hours between coats for the paint to dry

Tools you'll need:

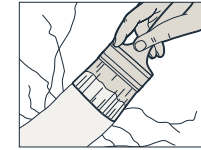
- 2" paint brush
- Paper roll



1
Add the finishing touches by applying our GoodHome windowsills and trims paint



2
Reseal any remaining paint cans and store according to instructions. **Do not empty down the drain**



3
If you have new render you may experience minor surface cracking as it dries and settles. Paint the affected area with another coat for added protection

All weather resistant

Provides protection in all climates, resistant to sun and rain



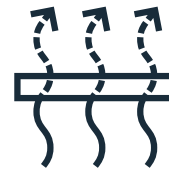
Water resistant

Keeps water out, protecting your masonry for longer



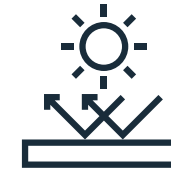
Water-based

Low odour. Clean your brushes and rollers with water



Breathable

Allows moisture to escape from your home



Long lasting colour

The painted surface looks fresh for longer



Anti-mould

Contains a biocide, resists mould growth



Self-cleaning

Dirt washes off when it rains



Crack resistant

Flexible formulation helps prevent small surface cracks appearing in the surface*



Abrasion resistant

Protects a surface from scuffs or damage in areas of high footfall like doorsteps or windowsills



Standing water resistance

Protects the surface where water may pool or collect on horizontal surfaces
