

Ceiling Tile Installation Guide – Short Instructions



1. Surface Preparation

The surface must be dry, clean, stable, smooth and absorbent.
Remove old wallpaper and glue-based paints.
Wash washable paints with soapy water; clean matte paints with detergent.
Prime raw or dusty surfaces.



2. Marking the Layout Lines

Mark lines dividing the ceiling into four equal parts.
This helps locate the room centre and ensures straight installation. Use a laser or chalk line.



3. Adhesive Application and Installation – Two Methods

Method A – Tube Adhesive: apply adhesive in vertical or zig-zag lines on the back of the tile. Fix the first tile at the intersection of the layout lines. Press gently and move the tile slightly left-right. Wipe off excess adhesive with a sponge or cloth.

Method B – Bucket Adhesive + Brush: apply adhesive along the edges of the tile with a brush. Apply adhesive in small points where the tile contacts the ceiling. Press the tile into place and make a slight left-right movement. Remove excess adhesive with a sponge or cloth.



4. Cutting the Tiles

Place the tile on the installed one. Hold another tile against the wall and mark the cutting line. Cut with a sharp knife and fix in place.

Materials and Tools

- ✓ Tube adhesive or bucket adhesive
- ✓ Caulking gun or narrow brush
- ✓ Sharp knife
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Sponge or cloth
- ✓ Laser or chalk line



Additional Information: Tiles can be painted once the adhesive has fully cured.
