Assembly Instructions

Before you start

Warnings

IMPORTANT, RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE READ CAREFULLY

See enclosed instructions for assembly, safety and care information.

Failure to follow the warnings could result in serious injury.

The product contains small parts which could pose a risk to young children. Keep small parts out of reach of children.

Children should not be allowed in the work area. Do not let them handle parts and tools. Do not allow children to climb on any part of the gazebo during assembly or when it is in use.

During all the processes of assembly, especially when lifting heavy or large parts, pay attention to your own safety. No one other than those persons assisting with the assembly should be allowed in the work area.

Handle heavy parts with care.

Ensure that this product is fully assembled as illustrated before use.

This product should only be used on firm, level ground.

Do not stand or climb onto this product.

This product is intended for domestic use only.

Ensure the product is always placed on level ground.

Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly used. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrect use of this product.

Dos

Select ideal location. the gazebo should be set up in the desired location to avoid moving it after assembly.

When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools, plenty of space and a clean, dry area for assembly.

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on suitable surface to prevent scratching your product.

Check the pack and make sure you have all of the parts listed.

Check all screws and bolts are tightened and inspect regularly.

To clean, wipe down with a sponge and warm soapy water and wipe with a clean, dry cloth.

Always use the provided stakes (optional parts: please check parts list) to secure your gazebo. If your item is set up on concrete / decking or asphalt please ensure it is secured down with concrete bolts (available at all good hardware stores).

To avoid damage to your gazebo, please ensure you remove the canopy and awning during high winds and adverse weather conditions.

Where instructions as to the; storage, commissioning, installation, use and maintenance of the goods or (if there is none) good trade practice are not followed and a defect arises this will void the 12 month manufacturer's guarantee on the product.

Don'ts

Do not use your gazebo for permanent shelter, it was designed for temporary use only.

Do not stand or climb onto the product.

Do not use power tools to construct this product.

Do not sit or lean onto the rims of this product.

Do not use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

Never use scourers, abrasives or chemical cleaner.

Never set up or continue to use in any rainy, windy or stormy conditions, especially during lightning storms. Damage can occur to your gazebo and put you and others in potential danger.

Do not use sharp, pointed or heavy object to cut, prick or hammer this product.

Do not use this product near a fire source.

Do not use this product as a parallel bar. It is not a piece of exercise equipment.

Assembly Instructions

This Gazebo with Awning should only be used as a sunshade.

Make sure the product is fixed firmly to the ground or have a suitable weighted base to hold them in place. If not secured or weighted down they will move position in high winds.

Please be aware that this product is not a permanent structure and we recommend removing the canopy/curtains between October and March. These are the months when the weather will cause damage to the fabric.

Warning

1. It is the consumer's responsibility to comply with any relevant local planning requirements.
2. Two-Four persons are required for assembly. The tools required are a screwdriver or wrench, stepladder and other relevant safety items such as gloves. We recommend the use of protective equipment.
3. This gazebo will take at least 1-2 hours to set up. You must allow enough time to complete the assembly. Do not leave it unattended if not fully assembled, even if bolted to the ground.
 - A. Make sure that all components are in the box. Read instructions carefully before starting the assembly.
 - B. Follow all instructions carefully to assure the strength of the gazebo.
 - C. In order to avoid damage to the gazebo and its components, use appropriate tools. Do not use the structure as a support; a stepladder is recommended.
 - D. Check all screws on a regular basis to maintain the solidity of the structure.
 - E. Keep the instructions and parts list for further use.
4. The screws/bolts to anchor to a wooden deck and concrete patio are not included.

Maintenance

1. In the event that your gazebo needs replacement parts, repairs or you require assistance with regards to assembly; please contact our customer sales team by email info@royalcraft.co.uk
2. For cleaning: Use a mild domestic soap or soft detergent and wash with warm water using a sponge or microfibre fabric. Rinse with clean water.
3. To preserve the fabric (canopy) we recommend the use of a UV protector spray like Fabsil. This will help block the harmful UV rays from damaging the fabric and will also keep the fabric protected from discoloration.




Please do not leave your canopy closed during high winds / rain or winter months as the water will collate on top causing a pool and damaging the structure.





Excluded

1. Damages due to vandalism, abuse and incorrect use of the product are not covered by the warranty
2. Damages due to extreme weather conditions such as thunderstorm, hail and high winds are not covered by warranty.
3. Canopy and/or Curtains will fade in the sunshine, the chemicals that make up the colours within the polyester fabric are broken down by ultraviolet light that is present in the sunshine, this is a natural process and is not covered by the guarantee or warranty. We do try to counteract this process by putting a UV resistant additive to the fabric however this only protects the fabric for a certain amount of time.

Step by step assembly instructions

Use Wrench (L) properly during the assembly process.

Step One

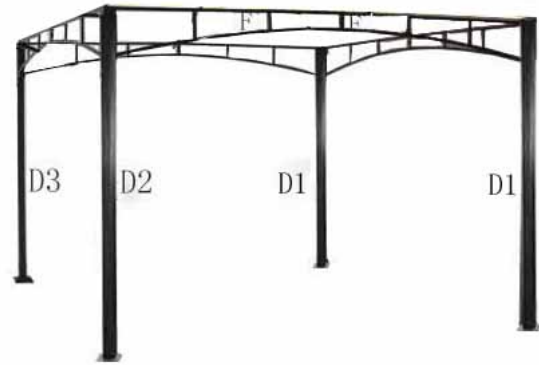
Attach the Lintel (F) to Lintel (F) with Bolt (G2). Repeat the aforesaid step, make the lintels into four groups.



Assembly Instructions

Step Two

Attach the Lintel (F) to Post (D1) with Bolt (G1), use the same way to assemble the Lintel (F) to Post (D2) and Post (D3). Make the Post (D2) and (D3) on the same level.



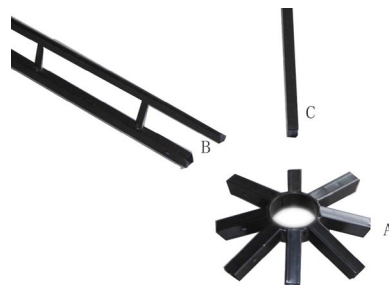
Step Three

Insert Roof support (B) into Roof support extension (B1), repeat the step, make the Roof Support into four groups.



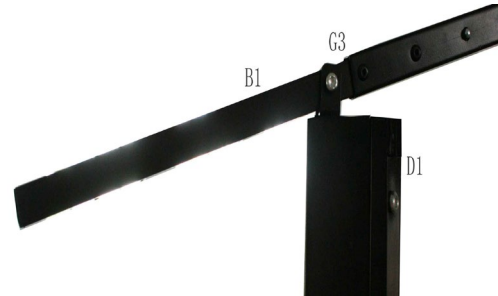
Step Four

Attach the Roof support (B), Short bar (C) to Big center connector (A), make them in to the top frame.



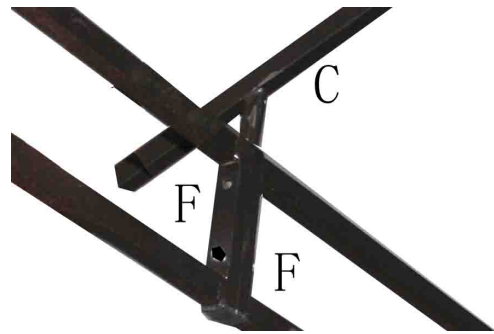
Step Five

Attach the Roof support extension (B1) to the post (D1) with Bolt (G3). Repeat the step, assembly (B1) to Post (D2) and Post (D3)



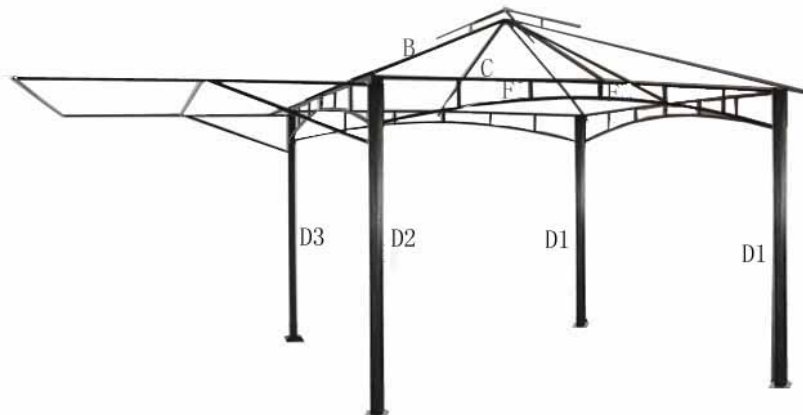
Step Six

Insert Short bar (C) to the hole of the Lintel (F) .



Step Seven

After all the parts are correctly assembled and all the bolts are fastened tightly, the frame will look like below diagram. (The awning frames are assembled at factory, no need assembly on your side)



Step Eight

Put the Awning fabric (K) on to the frame, then insert the awning middle support to the awning fabric.

Step Nine

Cover the Small canopy (H) to the small top, then cover the four corner knot of the small canopy onto the end of the roof support (B). Cover the big canopy to the big top, then cover four corner knot of the roof support extension (B1). Fix the gazebo to the ground by the stake(E) into the hole of the Post (D1/2/3)



Step Ten

The awning can be adjusted. Now we have completed the assembly.

The gazebo is ready for use.
