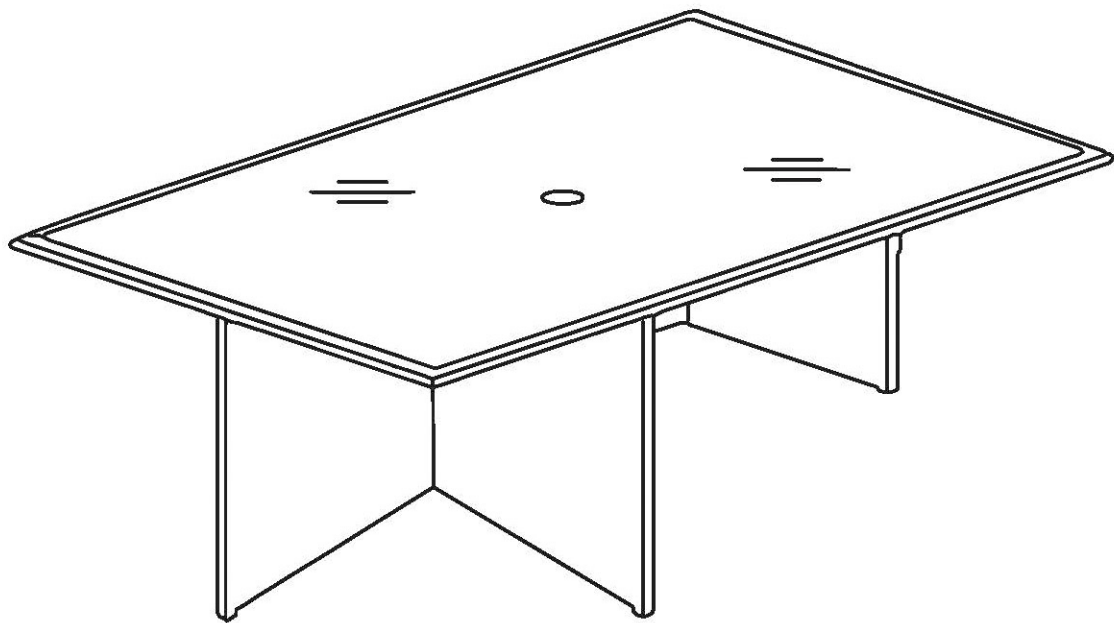

To best preserve the synthetic rattan, please use a protective cover when your furniture is not in use. We would also recommend using a gazebo or parasol over your furniture during the summer period and prolonged sunny spells. This will help prevent harmful UV rays from damaging and discolouring the material.

Ensure that the product is clean and dry before storage.

Clean your product with a sponge and warm soapy water then wipe with a clean, dry cloth.

When cleaning glass panels use a damp cloth or leather with washing up liquid or soft soap if necessary.

Don'ts

To preserve the table top design do not place greasy / oily items directly onto the surface. Use place-mats to prevent spillages of food or drink.

Do not place very hot or very cold items on the glass surface unless adequately thick table-mats are used to prevent such items from coming into contact with the glass.

Do not use the table as a chopping surface.

Do not strike the table with hard or pointed items.

Do not sit or lean on the table.

Do not use power tools to construct this product.

Do not use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

Do not stand or climb onto the product and do not use it as a ladder, as this could lead to it unbalancing and overturning.














Tips:

Step by step assembly instructions

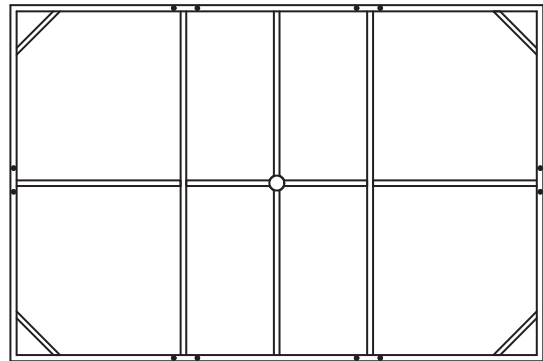
All Bolt Head Caps should not be attached before finally tightening all Bolts with Spanner.

Step One

Open the packaging, take out the contents and carefully leave the glass on the carton until the rest of the table is fully assembled.

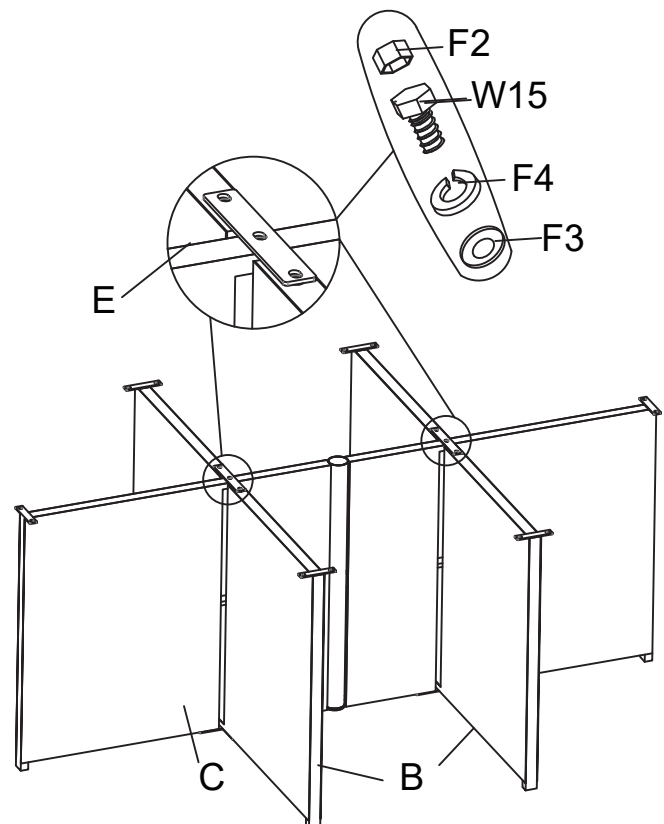
With the help of another person, place the Table Top Frame (A) upside down on a flat, non-abrasive surface to avoid scratching the table surface or rim.

Do NOT assemble the Legs (B&C) to the Table Top Frame (A) while it is still resting on the Glass Top (D).



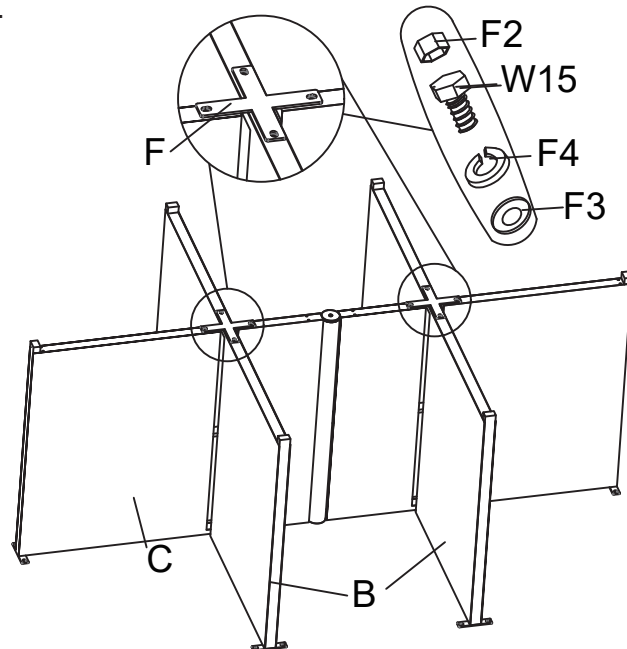
Step Two

With the help of another person, place the Long Leg (C) through the Short Legs (B), combine them by Connecting Panel (E) using Flat Washers (F3), Spring Washers (F4), Bolts (W15) and Bolt Head Caps (F2).



Step Three

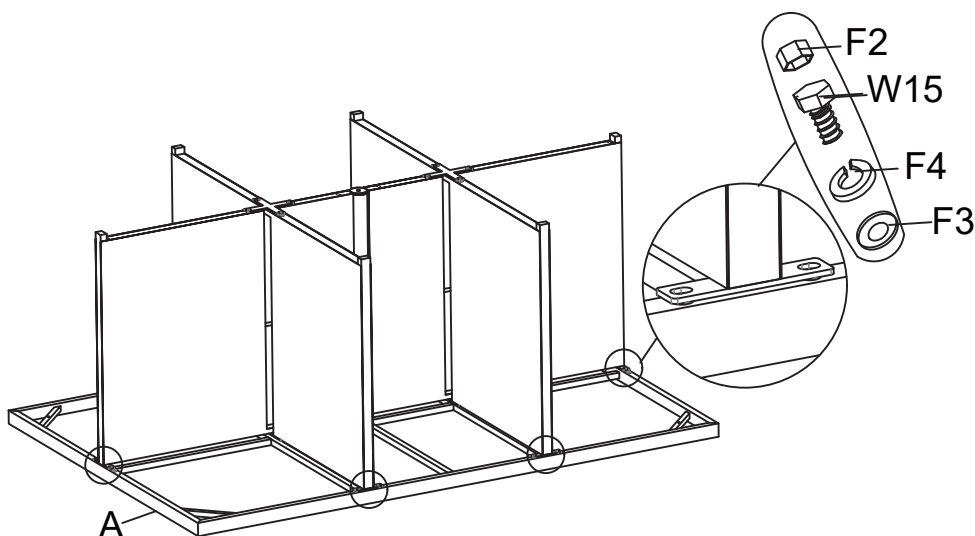
With the help of another person, turn over the above partly-assembled parts, combine them by Connecting Panel (F) using the Flat Washers (F3), Spring Washers (F4), Bolts (W15) and Bolt Head Caps (F2).



Step Four

With the help of another person, place the above partly-assembled parts onto the Table Top Frame (A) using the Flat Washers (F3), Spring Washers (F4), Bolts (W15) and Bolt Head Caps (F2).

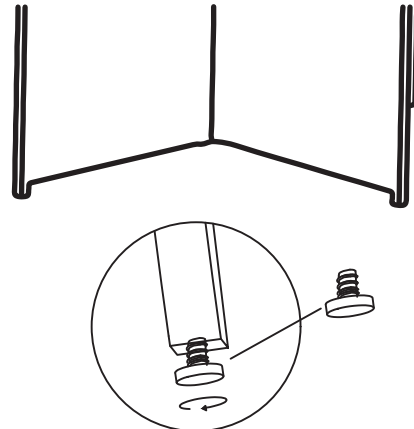
Once you are satisfied with the alignment of all components, carefully tighten all bolts using Spanner (S1), cover all Bolt Heads with Bolt Head Caps (F2).



Step Five

With the help of another person, carefully lift the partly-assembled table in upright position. Level the table with adjustable feet screws.

During this step (Levelling step and Bolts-tightening step), you may have to try for several times.



Adjustable Foot Screw

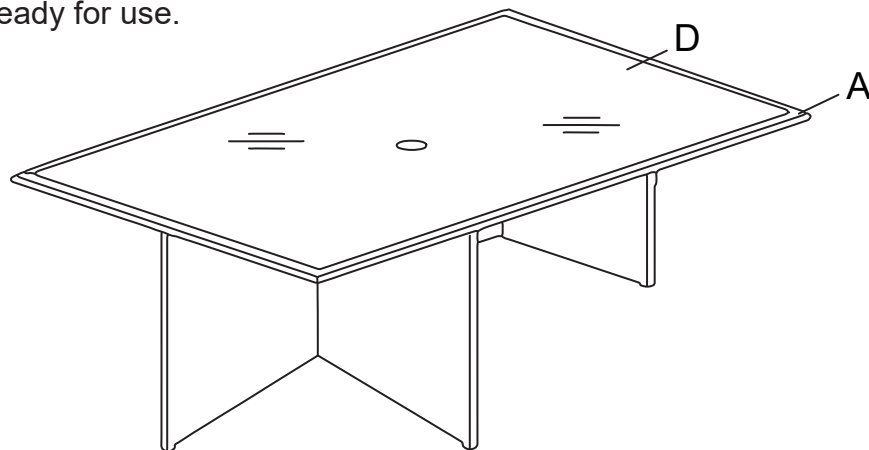
Step Six

With the help of another person, carefully lift the Glass Top (D) and place it onto the Table Top Frame (A).

The glass top should be securely inlaid into the Table Top Frame (A).

Make sure the glass top is evenly rested on the rubber pads which are pre-equipped on the inner edge of the Table Top Frame (A).

Your table is now ready for use.

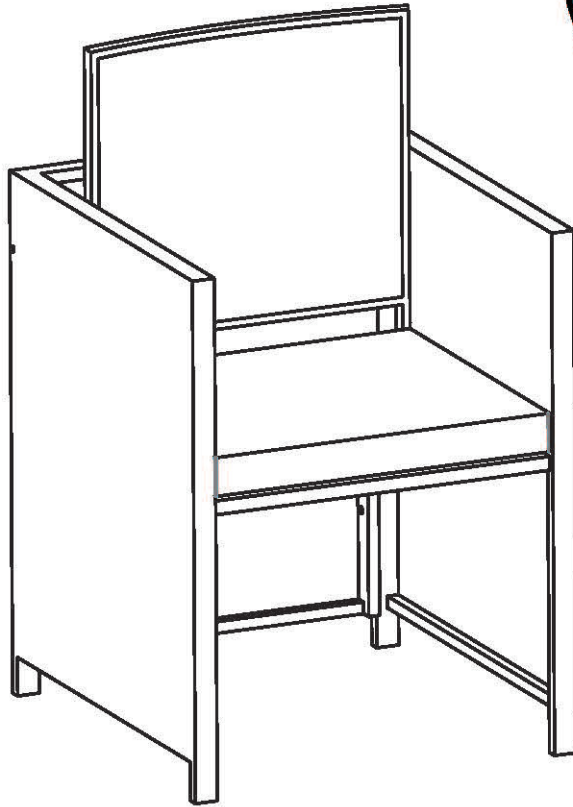


Note: If a parasol is used together with this Table, during high winds, the Parasol should be taken away and store in a safe place.

Step by step assembly instructions

Step One

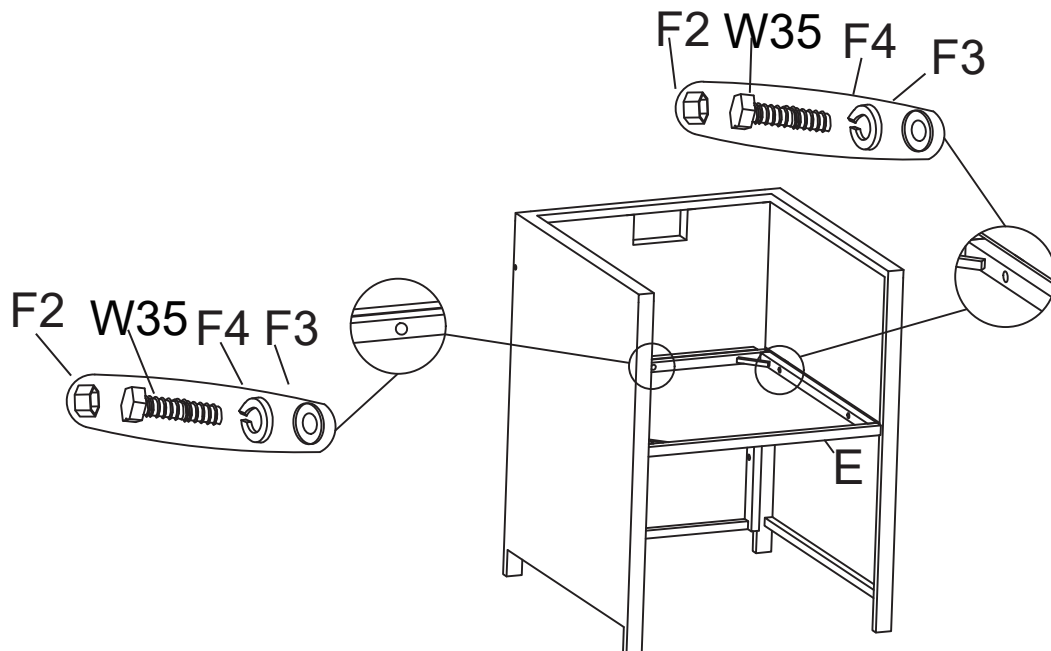
Attach Backrest (A) with Left Armrest/Leg(C) & Right Armrest/Leg (D) together using Flat Washers (F3), Spring Washers (F4), Bolts (W35), Bolts (W50) and Bolt Head Caps (F2).



Please note the Longer Bolts (W50) should be used on the top side.

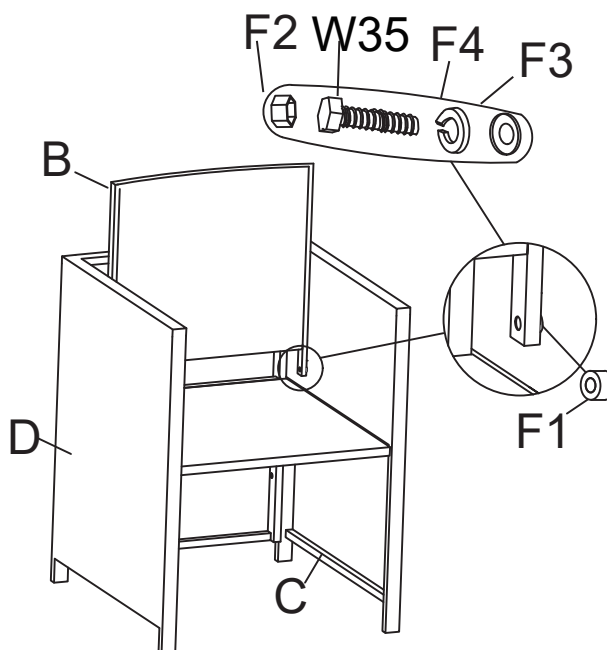
Step Two

Attach Seat Panel (E) to the above partly-assembled parts using Flat Washers (F3), Spring Washers (F4), Bolts (W35) and Bolt Head Caps (F2).



Step Three

Attach Foldable Backrest (B) to the above partly-assembled parts using Plastic Washer (F1), Flat Washers (F3), Spring Washers (F4), Bolts (W35) and Bolt Head Caps (F2).

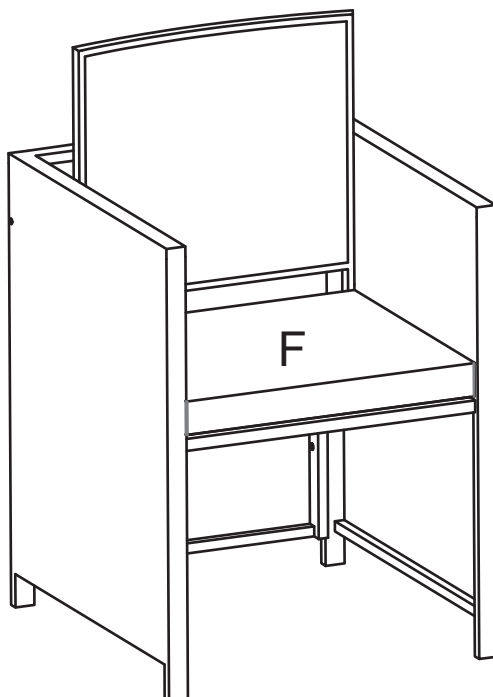


Please note the Plastic Washer (F1) is placed between the Parts (B) and (C or D).

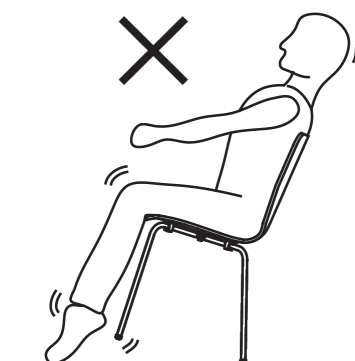
Step Four

Place the Seat Cushion (F) onto the Seat Panel (E).

Your chair is now ready for use.
