BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Make sure the unit is switched off
- Locate the battery cover on the train or fire tender (see fig. 1)
- Using a small cross blade screwdriver loosen the battery cover (see fig 2 and 3.)
- Carefully remove batteries if required
- Carefully insert 6 x AA batteries (not supplied)
- Replace the battery cover

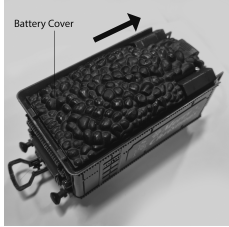

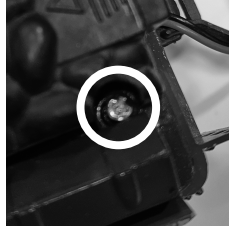

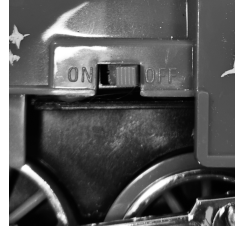

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- Attach the track together (see fig. 5)
- Carefully place the engine and the carriages on the assembled track so that all the wheels sit on the track
- Attach the carriages using the couplings on the rear of the engine/carriage
- Make sure the track is clear of obstructions and switch on (see fig. 4)

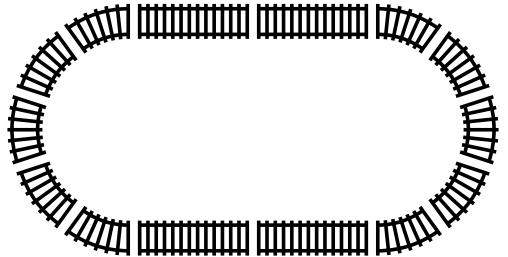
