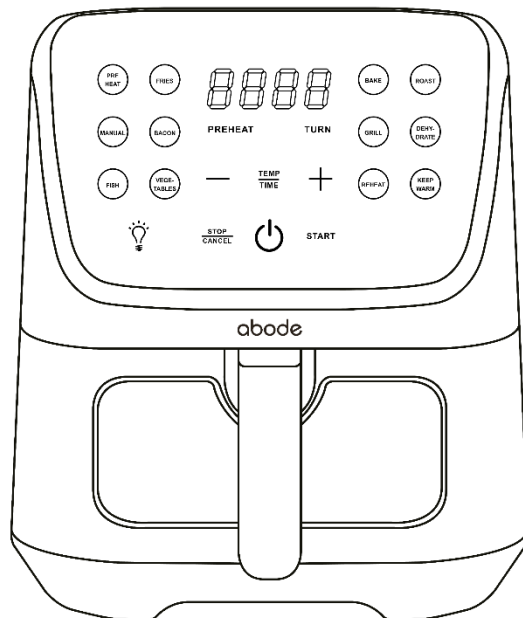

# **SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

## **READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USE AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**

- Check that the voltage indicated on the rating label corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the appliance to the mains power supply.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Children should not perform cleaning or user maintenance.
- Keep the appliance and its power supply cord out of the reach of children.
- This appliance is not a toy.
- This appliance does not contain user serviceable parts. If the power supply cord, plug or any part of the appliance is malfunctioning or if it has been dropped or damaged, only a qualified electrician should carry out repairs. Improper repairs may place the user at risk of harm.
- Keep the appliance and its power supply cord away from heat or sharp edges that could cause damage.
- Keep the power supply cord away from any parts of the appliance that may become hot during use.

- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Do not operate the appliance with wet hands.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the mains power supply.
- Do not remove the appliance from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch it off and remove the plug by hand.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Do not use any accessories other than those supplied.
- Do not use this appliance outdoors.
- Do not store the appliance in direct sunlight or in high humidity conditions.
- Do not move the appliance whilst it is in use.
- Do not touch any sections of the appliance that may become hot or the heating components of the appliance, as this could cause injury.
- Do not use sharp or abrasive items with this appliance; use only heat-resistant plastic or wooden spatulas to avoid damaging the non-stick surface.
- Always unplug the appliance after use and before any cleaning or user maintenance.
- Always ensure that the appliance has cooled fully after use before performing any cleaning or maintenance or storing away.
- Always use the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant surface, at a height that is comfortable for the user.

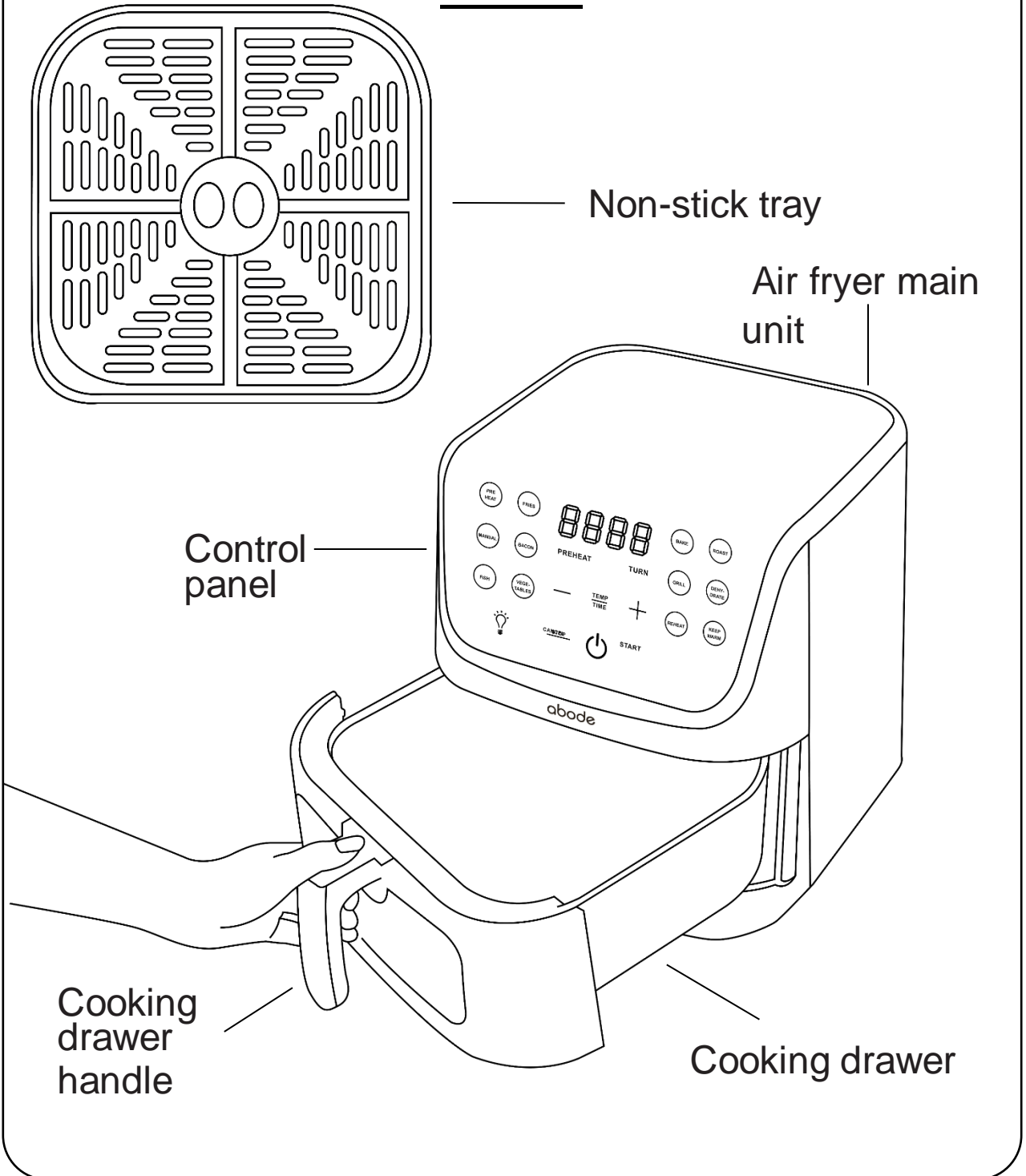

# GETTING STARTED

## Before first use

1. Remove all packaging materials and stickers or labels.
2. Check that the air fryer is switched off and unplugged from the mains power supply.
3. Clean the drawer in warm, soapy water and then rinse and dry thoroughly. Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
4. Never use harsh or abrasive cleaning detergents or scourers to clean the air fryer or its accessories, as this could cause damage.
5. Wipe inside and outside of the appliance with a soft, damp cloth and dry thoroughly.
6. Place the appliance on a stable, horizontal and even surface at a height comfortable for the user.
7. Allow for sufficient ventilation around the air fryer during use.

**Warning: Do not place the appliance on a non heat-resistant surface.**

**Note: When using the air fryer for the first time, a slight smoke or odour may be emitted. This is normal and will soon subside.**

It is advised to run the air fryer without food for approximately 10 minutes before first use; this will prevent the initial smoke or odour from affecting the taste of the food.

# USING YOUR AIR FRYER

## Operating Instructions

- Fit the non-stick coated cooking tray into the drawer.
- Slide the cooking drawer into the air fryer main unit to close it.

Note: The air fryer comes pre-assembled. The drawer should be closed securely before use, or the air fryer will not work.

- Plug in and switch on the air fryer at the mains power supply.
- Press on/off to turn the unit on.
- The air fryer will automatically select re-heat.
- Select the required programme and the temperature and time will be displayed.
- Remove the drawer by pulling it out of the air fryer using the handle.
- Place the drawer onto a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Place the ingredients into the non-stick coated cooking drawer and then slide the cooking drawer back into the air fryer to close it.
- To begin cooking press the start button.
- The selected programme will then remain illuminated along with the timer countdown.

### **Setting the temperature**

- The temperature button will adjust the temperature by 5° C at a time. Keeping the button held down will rapidly change the temperature.
- The temperature control range is 80° C – 200° C.
- This can be adjusted at any time.

# USING YOUR AIR FRYER

## Setting the cooking time

- The timing control button will adjust the cooking time by one minute at a time. Keeping the button held down will rapidly change the time. This can be adjusted during cooking at any time.
- Some ingredients may require shaking partway through the cooking time. The air fryer may prompt you to do this dependent on the programme selected.
- To shake your food, remove the drawer by pulling the handle, shake the drawer gently and then slide it back into the air fryer to close it and continue to cook.
- Once cooking is complete and the preset time has elapsed, check whether the food is ready by carefully opening the drawer.
- If the food is not cooked, close the drawer and use the timer to increase the cooking time.
- If the food is cooked, remove the non-stick coated drawer and then tip the contents into a bowl or onto a plate.
- To pause the air fryer press “stop/cancel” once, press again to turn the unit off.
- On switching the unit back on, it will default to re-heat again.

**Tip:** Select the light icon to view the food through the window.

**Note:** Use a pair of heat-resistant tongs (not included) if the food is large or fragile.

# USING YOUR AIR FRYER

- If the cooking time or temperature setting needs to be changed during use, simply use the control panel to set it as required and the air fryer will automatically adjust the settings.

**Caution:** Do not tip the food directly into a bowl or onto a plate, as excess oil may collect at the bottom of the drawer and leak onto ingredients.

**Warning:** Voltage is still present even when the appliance is turned to the off position. To permanently switch off the air fryer, turn it off at the mains power supply.

- Check that the air fryer is cool, clean and dry before storing in a cool, dry place.
- Never wrap the cord tightly around the air fryer; wrap it loosely to avoid causing damage.

## **AUTOMATIC SWITCH-OFF**

The air fryer is fitted with an automatic switch-off and this will activate if:

- The set cooking time has elapsed. The timer will sound and the automatic switch-off will activate, turning off the air fryer.
- The cooking drawer is pulled out from the air fryer during cooking. Once the cooking drawer is reinserted, the timer will continue to count down until the cooking time has elapsed.

# MAINTAINING YOUR AIR FRYER

## Cleaning

- Clean the appliance after every use.
- Before cleaning, remove the mains plug from the mains supply.
- Make sure your appliance has cooled down completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the outside of the appliance with a moist cloth.
- Clean the nonstick basket with warm, soapy water, then rinse and dry thoroughly.

**CAUTION: Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.**

**CAUTION: Never use harsh or abrasive cleaning detergents or scourers to clean the air fryer or its accessories, as this could cause damage.**

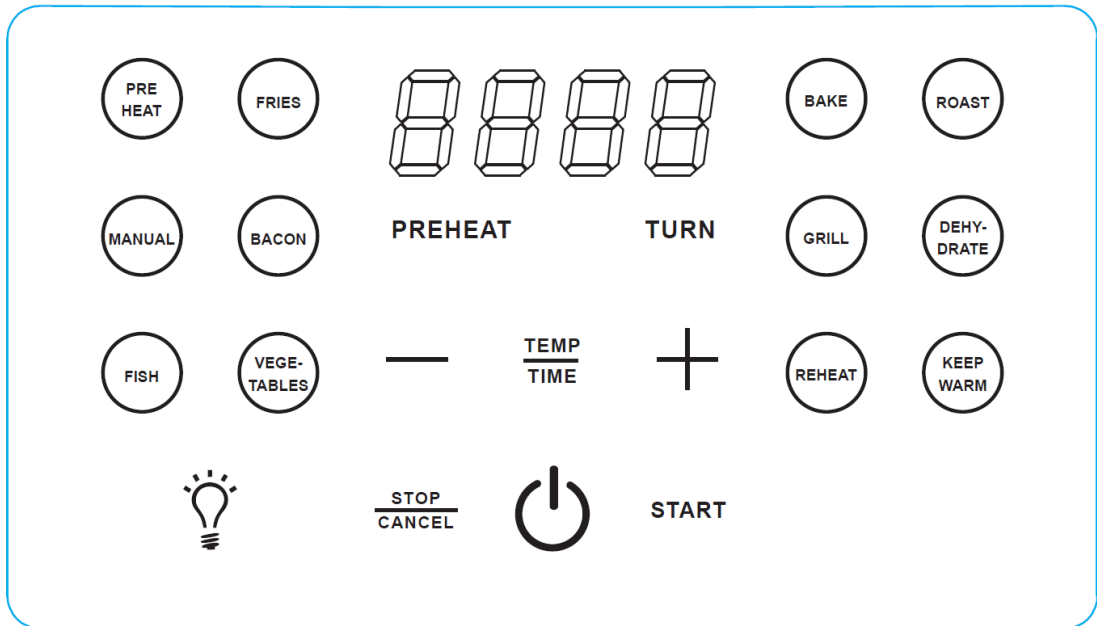
**WARNING: Always unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet before assembling, disassembling, relocating, servicing or cleaning it**

# MAINTAINING YOUR AIR FRYER

## Storage

- Ensure all parts are dry before storage.
- Store the appliance in a dry box or in a clean, dry place.
- Never store the appliance while it is still wet or dirty.
- Never wrap the power cord around the appliance.

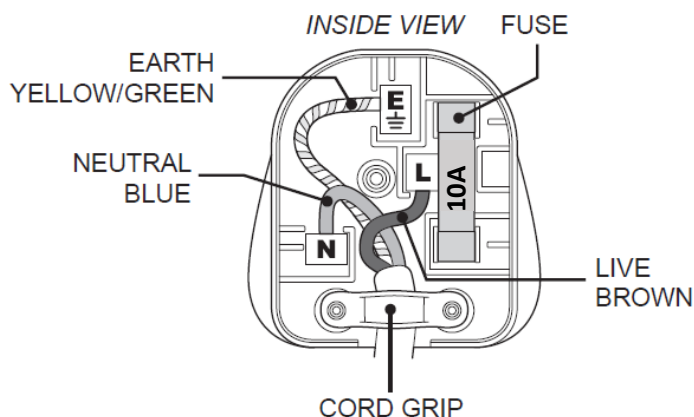

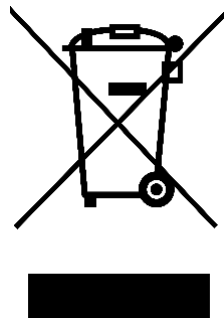
