

Roof Window Care Instructions

It is important to take care of your roof window in order to keep the sun shining in your home for longer.

If you opted for our trickle vented roof windows, it's important to clear out the air filter once every while. This can be done using ordinary household cleaning products. If your air filter is damaged. Please contact our team.



Rotate your sash 180 degrees and use a soft/glass friendly cloth, while using glass specific cleaning products. We advise removing jewellery and sharp objects before cleaning.



Once every so often, sweep and clean off the debris (if any) on your flashing. This allows water to correctly, and smoothly. Run off the roof window freely onto your roof and away from the roof window.



In areas or when pro-longed/heavy snowfall and ice is due. We recommend cleaning the channel gutters for water flow off the roof window. Your roof window will be the first place the snow melts.



Humidity causes condensation, which can be annoying! We know. A few ways to reduce humidity therefore, condensation include. Ventilation, De-humidifiers, closing doors from high moisture rooms and try to aim for a consistent room temperature of around 20 degrees.



Every few years we always advise lubricating the hinges and springs on your roof window. Although, your window is designed to last. Doing this can help it stay at its best performance for longer, ensuring a longer lifetime for the roof windows in your home.
