

### What's in my EcoQuilt Container Liner Insulation Kit?

If you have ordered a Container Liner Insulation Kit, without a floor section you should have received:

2 x Roof Sections (In Rolls, each labelled 'Roof')

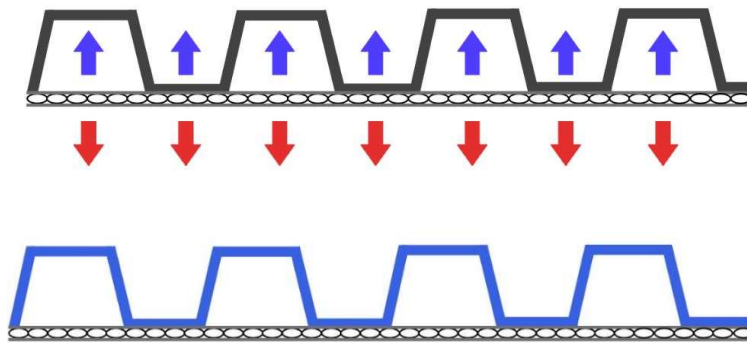
4 x Wall Sections (In Rolls, each labelled 'Wall')

Silver Foil Joining Tape – To Seal All Edges and Joints.

### Where do I start?

- ➔ Start by ensuring that the container is clean and dry, specifically you want the container to be dust and grease free.

***Before you start fixing the insulation in to place, do not adhere the membrane into the vertical apertures; the membrane should be flat against the wall.***



EcoQuilt is commonly ordered by those converting, as the material is made up of layers that expand between the cavities.

**We would advise following one of the two installation methods.**

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Option

- 1) Build a batten frame around the perimeters
- 2) Create studwork at 400mm centres
- 3) Staple insulation to the battens
- 4) Add another 25mm batten over the top before boarding

This option would generate 40% higher performance, as you have an air space either side of the insulation.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Option

- 1) Insulate directly on to the container
- 2) Create a framework over the top (using battens)
- 3) Board
