NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box is designed to safely hold the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps, and rodenticides such as NOPE!® Rat Killer, and is lockable to prevent access by children, birds, pets, farm animals and other non-target animals. The **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** is supplied with a removable insert for dividing the box, a metal rod to pierce and hang rodenticides on and a key to unlock the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** for removal of waste bait and dead rodents.

Application Information

Preparation

Before any treatment the site should be monitored to identify the rodent species, their preferred routes, the size of the infestation and the rodent's food and drinking sources.

Prior to the use of rodenticide products such as NOPE!® Rat Killer, non-chemical control methods (e.g. traps) should be considered. For improved bait acceptance, use a bait that closely resembles the food sources the rodents have been consuming, as this increases the likelihood of them recognizing and ingesting the bait.

Take preventative control measures, such as plugging entry and exit holes and removing food and drinking sources, which are readily attainable for rodents (e.g. spilled grain, food waste or leaks) to improve product intake and reduce the likelihood of reinfestation. Avoid disturbing the area excessively as this may deter rodents returning to the area and reduce bait acceptance.



Application

Read and follow the product information as well as any information accompanying the product or provided at the point of sale before using it.

Most rodenticides contain anticoagulant substances. Do not use anticoagulant rodenticides as permanent baits (e.g. for prevention of rodent infestations or to detect rodent activity). If ingested, symptoms which may be delayed, may include nosebleed and bleeding gums. In severe cases, there may be bruising and blood present in the faeces or urine. **ANTIDOTE: VITAMIN K1 ADMINISTERED BY MEDICAL/VETERINARY PERSONNEL ONLY.**

KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM TREATED AREAS. Place the treated **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** **OUT OF THE REACH** of children, birds, pets, farm animals and other non-target animals. Place **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** **AWAY FROM** food, drink and animal feeding stuff, as well as from utensils or surfaces that have contact with these. **DO NOT** place **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** near water drainage systems where they can come into contact with water.

Rodenticides such as NOPE!® Rat Killer must be secured in the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box**, hanging on the included rod, insert the recommended amount of bait from the rodenticide product.

When using rodenticide products do not eat, drink or smoke. Wash hands and directly exposed skin after using rodenticide products.

In case of:

- Dermal exposure, wash skin with water and then with water and soap
- Eye exposure, rinse eyes with eyes-rinse liquid or water, keep eye lids open for at least 10 minutes
- Oral exposure, rinse mouth carefully with water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do not provoke vomiting. If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately and show the rodenticide products container or label. UK medical professionals should contact the National Poisons Information Service (www.npis.org) for further advice. **CONTACT A VETERINARY SURGEON IN CASE OF INGESTION BY A PET.**

When using NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps make sure the traps are locked in place in the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box**, use a **NON-TOXIC** bait. It is recommended to leave the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps baited but **UNARMED** for a few days to allow the rats to become accustomed to the trap's presence and start consuming the bait. Once the bait is consumed, it is recommended to re-bait then **ARM** the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps.

Once rodenticides, or NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps, are secured in the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box**, they should be placed in the immediate vicinity where rodent activity has been observed (e.g. travel paths, nesting sites, feedlots, holes, burrows etc.). Where possible, **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** must be fixed to the ground or other structures. Place the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** in areas non-labile to flooding. Replace any bait in the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** which has been damaged by water or contaminated by dirt.

Check on the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** at regular intervals, following the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps, or rodenticides instructions, once securely placed. Search for and remove dead rodents during inspections and re-filling of **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box**.

If the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps are untriggered, or rodenticide bait is untouched after 35 days, the bait should be removed to remove the risk of non-target species consuming the toxic bait, or being captured by the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps.

If the NOPE!® Rat Snap Traps are still capturing rodents, or rodenticide bait is still being consumed and rodent activity is still observed after 35 days, consideration could be given to contacting a professional pest control service.

Poisoned rodents should be double-bagged using plastic bags and either disposed of in a household waste bin with a secure lid to prevent access of wildlife and pets or collected by a specialist waste contractor or the local authority. Rodents can be disease carriers. Do not touch dead rodents with bare hands, use gloves or tools such as tongs when disposing of them.

Remove the remaining bait and/or the **NOPE!® Rodent Bait Box** at the end of the treatment period. Dispose of uneaten bait and the packaging in accordance with local requirements. Waste bait should be double bagged in plastic bags and disposed of in a household waste bin with a secure lid to prevent access of wildlife and pets or should be taken to a civic amenity site. For information on civic amenity sites contact your local authority.

Other Information

Apply only in areas that are not liable to submersion or becoming wet, i.e. protected from rain, floods and cleaning water. Do not contaminate foodstuffs, eating utensils or food contact surfaces. Keep away from food, drink and animal foodstuffs. For use only in indoor areas for mice/rats and outdoors around buildings for rats only. Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after use. Cover all water storage tanks before application. All bats are protected under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. Before treating any structure used by bats, consult The Bat Conservation Trust and the relevant statutory authority for guidance and advice: Natural England, NatureScot or Natural Resources Wales. Do not contaminate waterbodies or watercourses with chemicals or used containers.
