

Pest Repeller Instructions

2 in 1 Pest Repeller

Effective in repelling: Rats, mice, spiders and most crawling insects.

Combines two pest control systems

The 2 in 1 Pest Repeller combines two different pest control systems: electromagnetic interference and ultrasonic sound. It covers approximately 2000sqft (an average 4 bed home).

How does it work?

Ultrasound - a loud noise at a high frequency that rodents and insects can hear but that is too high for humans or pets. Because it doesn't pass through solid objects, ultrasound will only be effective in the room you plug it into.

Electromagnetic interference – Rats, mice and insect pests spend most of their time living in the walls, ceilings and floors. The device overcomes this problem by sending a varying electrical pulse throughout the wiring of the whole house. Whenever electricity passes through a wire, an electromagnetic field is created: the manufacturers believe that the particular fields created by this device create an environment that prevents rodents nesting and so drives them out of your house. Insect pests are thought to suffer an irritation and disturbance to their nervous systems, driving them out of the house.

Where do I plug it in?

Plug the device into the room where you have seen most pest activity. Simply plug the device into a wall socket. Ultrasound is only effective in the room space that you plug it into. The electromagnetic interference will be effective throughout the house – wherever there are electrical wires. The effect spreads out up to 3 feet from each wire.

Trouble shooting

Most problems will disappear within a few days.

Rodents: if you have rodent problems, they may already have built a nest in your house. If this is the case, they are unlikely to desert their young until they are old enough to move. Fortunately, rodents mature quickly and the babies will be fully grown within a month.

What if they haven't left?

Make sure the LED is on. Ensure all sources of food have been shut away/removed and the area is clean. Plug the unit in close to areas of activity so the ultrasonic will be most effective in that area.



It will not affect any electrical equipment like computers or burglar alarms.

It will not affect cats, dogs, birds, reptiles, fish or children.

The device may affect rodent pets such as gerbils, hamsters or chinchillas. If you do have such a pet, it's advisable to remove them while the device is switched on – either outside/in a shed (at least 2m away from any wiring connected to the house) or with a friend or neighbor.
