

## CHURCHILL CHAIR / BENCH ASSEMBLY

Please note whilst we use images of a bench, these instructions are correct for both chairs & benches, chairs do not have a centre support bar – images are for illustration only

### PARTS LIST:

1 X SEAT PANEL (SEAT)  
1 X BACK PANEL (BACK)  
1 x LH LEG ASSEMBLY  
1 x RH LEG ASSEMBLY  
2 x SUPPORT BARS

A: 12 X BOLTS



B: 12 X WASHERS



C: 12 X NUTS



D: 1 X SCREW 5X100 (NOT USED FOR CHAIRS)



E: 8 x SCREWS 5X70 (4 NEEDED FOR CHAIRS)

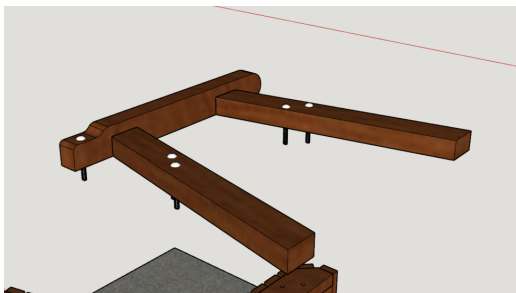


F: 4 X SCREW CAPS



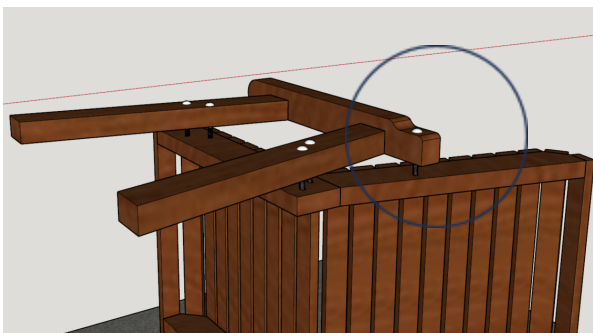
#### Step 1:

Position the seat and back panel as shown on a flat surface so they line up.



#### Step 2:

Push the bolts (A) provided through the leg assembly, tapping with a hammer if needed.



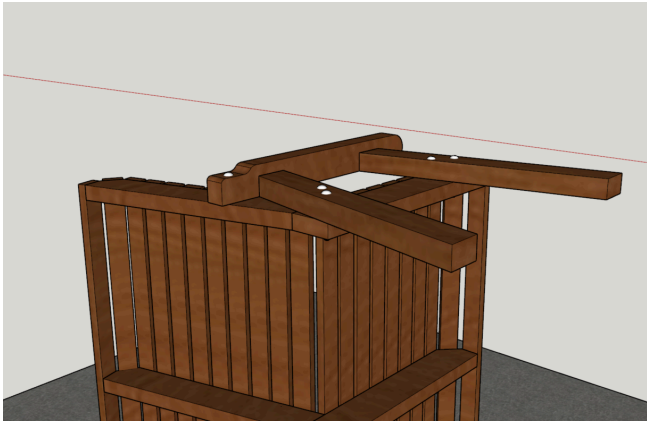
#### Step 3:

Position the leg assembly as shown so the bolts are in line with the holes, ensuring the curved cutout is to the back of the armrest and on the outside of the assembly.

Guide the bolts through the receiving holes and tap them through with a hammer.

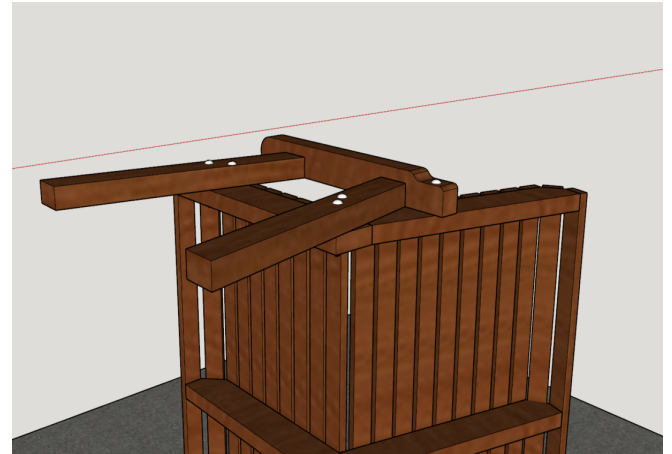


Step 4: Give the bolts a firm hit with the hammer, so the cup square part of the bolt penetrates the wood, and the bolt is in position properly, then fit a washer (B) followed by a nut (C), and finger tighten them.



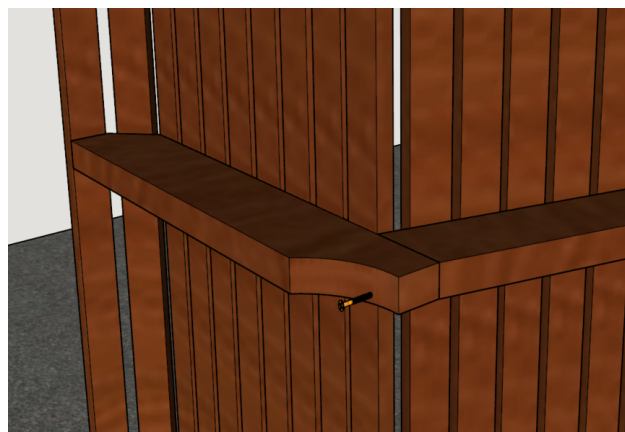
Step 5:

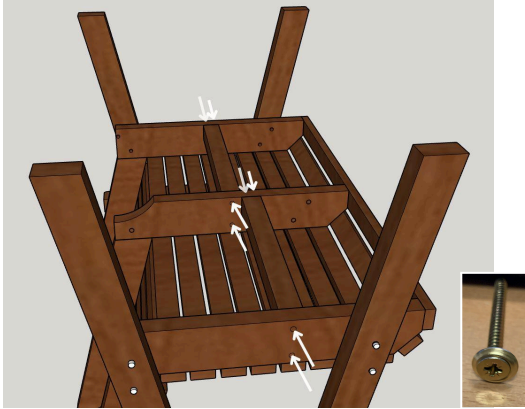
Turn the seat over and repeat the above process to fit the other leg assembly.



For benches screw (D) in place as shown to support the middle section as shown.

\*This step does not apply to chair assembly.





**Step 6:**

Position the 2 support bars in a staggered formation as illustrated (Chairs will only have 1 support bar). Secure each bar using 8 screws (D) in total - 2 screws on each side of each bar - following the arrow guides. Ensure screw caps (E) are placed on each of the outside screws for a finished look. Note - screw caps go on before you screw in - see illustration



**Final step:**

Stand the seat upright and tighten the nuts up to complete.

Enjoy your new product.

## **Product Information**

Your furniture has been given a one coat base treatment with antifungal, anti-mould and UV protection.

To help protect and extend the life of your furniture, we recommend an additional application of a suitable oil-based wood protector or preservative soon after delivery, and then annually to help maintain the longevity of your furniture.

We stock our own 'Rhino oil' which is available in the Valley Golden Oak tint, to help enrich and maintain the original colour of your furniture, or clear.

Wood is a natural product and minor splits, and shade variations are characteristic of the softwood used in the production of this furniture. We strongly recommend the use of a protective treatment to help protect from excessive drying and splitting during extreme weather conditions, and to help weatherproof your furniture.

We recommend periodic checking and tightening of nuts and bolts if required as your furniture ages.
