



EasyComposite™ Composite Decking Kit – Safety Guide

1. Overview

This Safety Guide outlines important information to help ensure safe handling, installation, and use of the **EasyComposite™ Decking Kit**. Please read carefully before starting any work.

2. General Safety

- Always follow the **EasyComposite™ Installation Guide**
 - Keep the work area clean, dry, and free from obstacles
 - Do not allow children or pets near the installation area
 - Never rush installation—plan work carefully

3. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

The following PPE is recommended during installation:

- Safety gloves (to protect against sharp edges and splinters)
 - Safety goggles (especially when cutting materials)
 - Dust mask (when sawing composite boards)
 - Safety footwear (to protect against dropped materials)

4. Manual Handling

- Decking boards (3.6m length) can be **long and awkward to handle**
 - Use **two-person lifting** where possible
 - Lift with care—bend knees and keep back straight
 - Avoid twisting while carrying materials
-

5. Cutting & Tool Safety

- Use a **fine-tooth saw blade** suitable for composite materials
- Ensure tools are in good working condition
- Secure materials before cutting
- Keep hands clear of cutting areas at all times



- Disconnect power tools when not in use
-

6. Dust & Ventilation

- Cutting composite materials may produce **dust particles**
 - Always work in a **well-ventilated area**
 - Wear a dust mask to avoid inhalation
 - Clean up dust regularly to prevent buildup
-

7. Installation Surface & Stability

- Ensure the base is **stable, level, and secure** before installation
 - Do not install directly onto soft ground such as soil or grass
 - Check all joists are properly supported and fixed
 - Avoid working on uneven or unstable surfaces

8. Slips, Trips & Falls

- Composite boards can be **slippery when wet or dusty**
 - Keep the work surface clean and dry during installation
 - Remove offcuts, tools, and debris promptly
 - Wear appropriate footwear with good grip
-

9. Fixings & Components

- Use only the **supplied clips and appropriate fixings**
 - Ensure all fixings are secure before walking on the deck
 - Do not leave partially fixed boards unattended
-

10. Weather Considerations

- Avoid installation during **heavy rain, frost, or strong winds**
 - Be cautious in hot weather, as materials may expand and surfaces may become hot

11. Post-Installation Safety

- Check all boards and trims are securely installed
 - Ensure no sharp edges or loose components remain
 - Keep the deck surface clean to reduce slip risk
-

12. Emergency Advice

- In case of injury, seek medical attention immediately
 - For minor cuts or injuries, use appropriate first aid
 - Always keep a basic first aid kit nearby during installation
-
