RECOMMENDED RANGES FOR BALANCED WATER

pH	7.2 - 7.6
Total Alkalinity	80 - 150 ppm
Free Chlorine	2-4 ppm
Total Chlorine	Below 5 ppm
Bromine	3-5 ppm
Calcium Hardness	150 - 250 ppm

This table shows the ideal balanced measurements that you are looking for in your test results. Parts per million (ppm), is a form of most pool and spa chemical readings. This is equivalent to one milligram of concentration per litre of water.

USER GUIDE

Welcome to the your weekly spa care experience! We're excited to guide you through the simple steps to maintain your spa water effectively. We recommend reading this user manual thoroughly to keep your spa water clean and eco-friendly.

Inside your weekly spa care box, you'll find everything you need for your spa maintenance routine:

- 1 x 2-litre bottle of Softener Solution A
- 1 x 2-litre bottle of Cleanse Solution B
- 1 x Measuring jug
- 1 x User manual

GETTING STARTED

When you're adding our weekly spa care solution for the first time, make sure to thoroughly clean your spa. It's common to find biofilm, calcium, and other contaminants in the pipes.

If you're dealing with some common long-term hot tub issues like biofilm or those pesky flakes in the water, try using a pipe cleaner first to speed up the cleaning process.

Whether you're starting afresh with new water or your tub's water has been in action for a while, it's a good idea to run the pumps for better mixing.

USE WITH A NEW SPA

If you've got a new spa, starting off with our weekly spa care solution is a great idea since it keeps sediment at bay.

It's totally normal for some contamination to happen during transport and storage of a new spa. To get things sparkling clean, treat your new spa with either chlorine shock or a spa pipe cleaner.

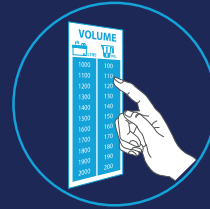
Now, here's the thing: your water might look a bit cloudy for the first few weeks. But fear not! Our weekly spa care solution is here to the rescue. It'll work its magic by loosening up all those contaminants, even if your water isn't crystal clear right away.

Oh, and a quick reminder: during this time, it's a good idea to disinfect by adding some extra sanitiser to make sure everything stays nice and clean.

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

To enjoy clear, silky-soft, and hygienically clean water in your spa, simply use the measuring jug provided to add the right amount of Softener Solution A and Cleanse Solution B to your spa water.

You can find the recommended quantities via the weekly dosing chart on the bottle labels or in this user guide for your convenience.



Let's start by turning on the pumps and ensuring all the jets and waterfalls are open to get things flowing nicely. Give both bottles a good shake before use.

Next up, add the right amount of Softener Solution A to the hot tub water using the measuring jug provided.



Now, let's add the correct amount of Cleanse Solution B to the hot tub water using the measuring jug provided. Almost there!



Lastly, it's time to check and adjust the pH and sanitiser level. You can find the recommended levels in this user guide for reference.

SPA CARE MAINTENANCE TIPS

Here are some handy tips for keeping your spa water in tip-top shape:

- Get the weekly spa care solution App from the App Store or Google Play to make water maintenance a breeze!
- If you've got an extra filter handy, consider swapping them out during cleaning sessions for an extra boost.
- Keep those jets, waterfalls, or fountains slightly open at all times to maintain a healthy flow and keep those pipes sparkling clean.
- Maintaining clean and clear water can be a bit tricky sometimes! There are several factors that come into play to ensure your water stays pure and crystal clear. Things like alkalinity (TA), pH levels, and calcium content in your tap water can all affect the quality of your spa water. Remember, it's recommended by spa manufacturers to change the water in your spa every 3 to 4 months.
- Always fill your spa with clean mains water. Be sure to let the water sitting in the garden hose drain away first, as it can contain bacteria.

SAFETY FIRST

- Always use according to the instructions.
- Remember to store these products out of reach of children.
- Keep the bottle cap tightly closed at all times.
- Accidents can happen. If someone accidentally ingests undiluted Solution A or Solution B, it's important to drink plenty of water right away. Don't make them vomit and avoid giving them alcohol. Seek medical help immediately.
- If undiluted Solution A or Solution B comes into contact with eyes, wash thoroughly with water and seek medical help immediately.

RECYCLING REMINDER

Recycle empty bottles if you can. Otherwise, dispose of them properly.
