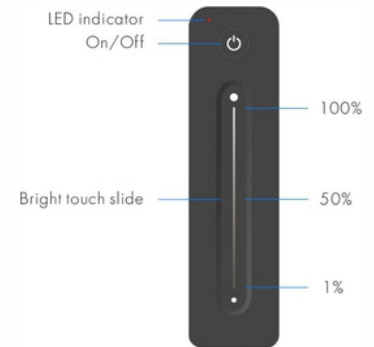
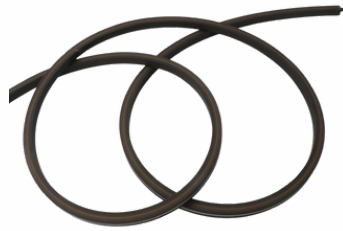


LED Light Strips

SETTING UP THE LIGHTS



WHAT'S IN THE PACK

- LED STRIPS
- POWER ADAPTER/ WT5 RECEIVER
- POWER SPLITTER (WITH 6-WAY CONNECTOR)
- REMOTE CONTROL
- 1× SILICONE END CAP (OPTIONAL, FOR CUT ENDS)
- DC EXTENSION CABLE (EXTRA 2M LENGTH)

Unpack LED strips

- Unwind each strip and lay flat.
- ⚠ Handle carefully—bending can cause large dark spots. Small spots may appear at first but will fade once flattened.

Connect the strips

- Plug each LED strip into a connector on the power splitter.

Connect power supply to mains

- Plug into a wall socket.
- ⚠ Do not connect LED strips directly to 240V mains power or a wall outlet—this is dangerous and a fire risk.

Test the lights

- Set up the remote control to switch on and adjust brightness.
- Remote set up: Press match/set button on the WT5, the LED indicator will flash for pairing mode, immediately press the on/off button on the remote. The LED indicator will flash when match is successful.
- Confirm all strips are working before installation.

Check before cutting or installing

- If you see damage, stop and contact our support team at 0121 387 8717

⚠ Cutting the strips voids the warranty.



INSTALLATION GUIDE

Installing Strip Lights on Slat Wood Wall Panels – Quick & Easy (No Adhesives Required!)

Before you begin, please check the contents of your box to ensure you have everything you need.

Step 1: Plan Wire Management

Decide how you'd like to conceal the wires. For a cleaner look, consider installing your panels on batten strips, which makes it easier to run wires behind the panels.

Step 2: Position the Lights

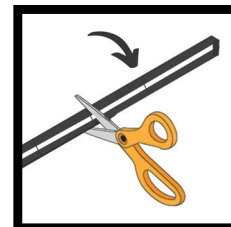
Lay out the LED strips to determine placement. Make sure the power switch is easily accessible. Plug in the lights to test functionality before installation.

Step 3: Mark and Measure

Choose the exact location on the panel where you'd like to install the strips. Measure and mark points where the strips may need to be cut.

Step 4: Cutting the Strips

- Important: Unplug the power supply before cutting.
- Locate the dark cut lines on the white line located on the back of the strip (spaced 50mm apart). These indicate safe cutting points.
- Using scissors, carefully cut straight across the strip.
- ⚠️ Note: Cutting the strips voids the warranty.



Step 5: Install the Strips

- Start at the bottom edge of the panel.
- Press the strip firmly into place so that the LED surface sits flush with the panel surface.
- If your panel has a wood veneer, avoid sliding your hand along the surface—press small sections in using your palm or thumb to prevent splinters.
- Continue until all desired strips are installed.

Hiding Wires

- Bottom wires: conceal beneath skirting boards.
- Top wires: run above the panels, or behind the panels if they are mounted on batten strips.

Rearranging

Want a new look? The LED Strips are easy to remove and reposition. Simply start at either end of the strip and gently pull.
