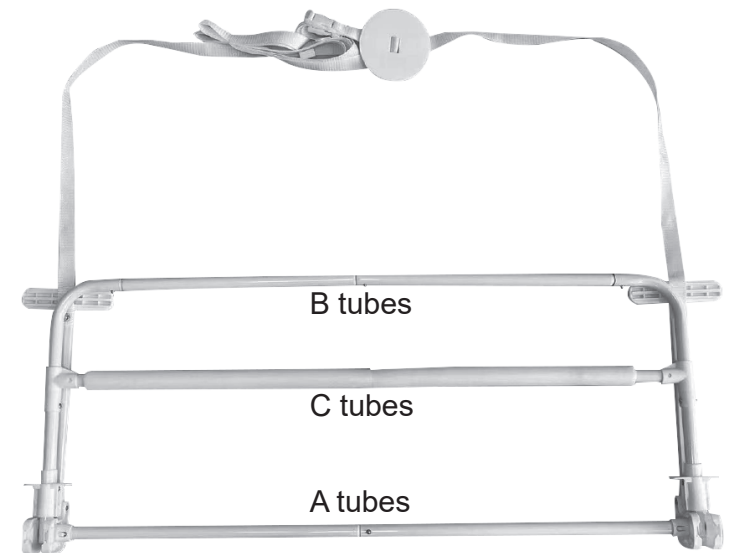
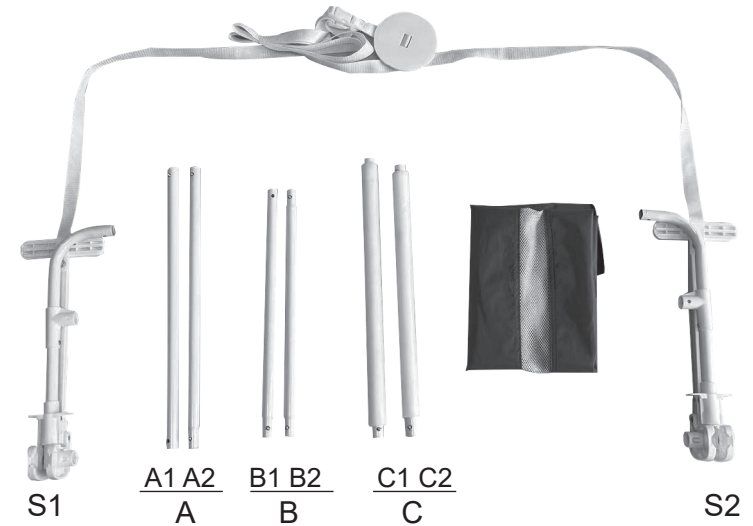


Before You Start

Please read all instructions carefully and keep it for future reference.

General Warnings

- Attention: To prevent possible injury by entanglement, remove this toy when the child starts trying to get up on its hands and knees in a crawling position.
- Danger! Keep all small parts and packaging materials for this product away from babies and children, otherwise they may pose a choking hazard.
- The product must be installed and used under the supervision of an adult.
- Read through each step carefully and follow the proper order.
- Remove all packaging, separate and count all parts and hardware before installation.
- Please ensure that all parts are correctly installed, incorrect installation can lead to a danger.
- We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
- Ensure a secure surface during installation, and always place the product on a flat, steady and stable surface.

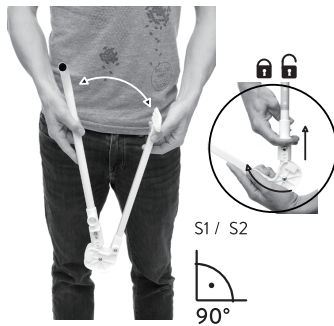

Assembly Instruction

1. Open the S1 and S2 legs, keep the tube and feet at a 90 degree angle.



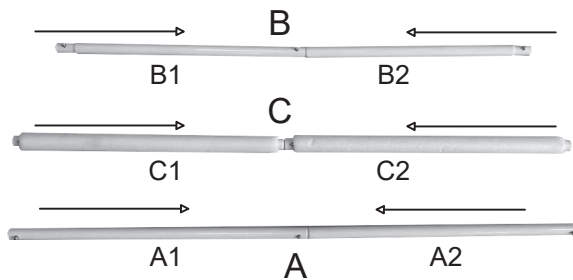
2. Assemble the set A, set B and set C tubes.



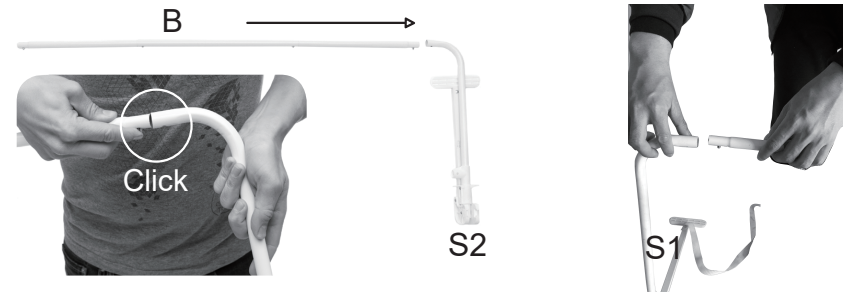
$B = B1 + B2$

$C = C1 + C2$

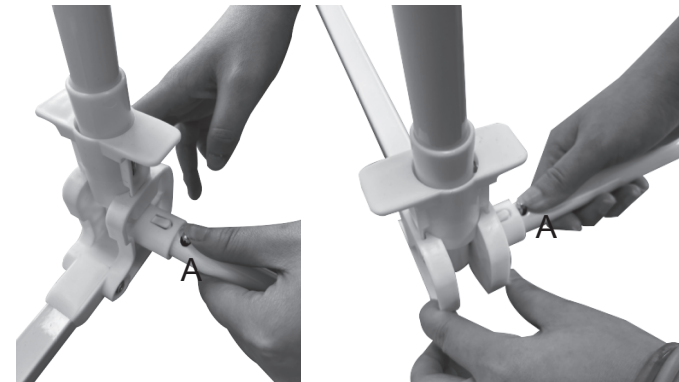
$A = A1 + A2$



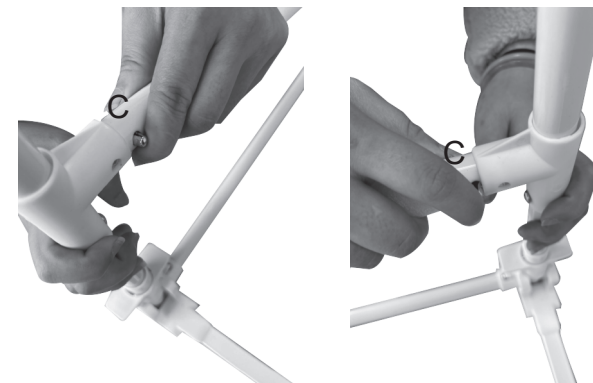
3. Connect set B with the top of S1 & S2.



4. Connect Set A with the bottom of S1 & S2.



5. Connect Set C with the bottom of S1 & S2 as per picture.



6. Cover the S1, S2, A and B with a cloth cover



7. Pull up the zipper on the fabric cover.

Please Note: The fabric cover needs to be stretched out with force, ensuring each corner is properly positioned so that the zipper can be fastened. Otherwise, it may seem as if the fabric cover is too small. In fact, as long as every part is smoothed out, the zipper can be fastened. If the fabric cover is too large, it will not be neat after the zipper is zipped up, which may present safety risks.



TIP: When disassembling this product, after removing the cloth cover, first remove the C tube.

WARNING

ENTRAPMENT HAZARD
NEVER use bedrail without properly securing bedrail to bed. Incorrect installation can allow bedrail to move away from mattress, which can lead to entrapment and death.

WARNING

SUFFOCATION AND STRANGULATION HAZARD
Gaps in and around bedrails have entrapped young children and killed infants.

NEVER use with children younger than 18 months old or over 16 KG. Use ONLY with older children who can get in and out of adult bed without help. NEVER use in place of crib.

NEVER use unless bedrail is tight against mattress without gaps, and at least 250mm(10in) from headboard and footboard. Do not fill gaps with pillows, blankets, or other items that can suffocate children. NEVER use on toddler bed, bunk bed, water bed, or bed with inflatable mattress. Use ONLY on adult bed.

Use ONLY on the mattress of the bed with a correct thickness (at least 4.72"/12 cm and maximum 11.81"/30 cm) and hardness. The bedrail is ONLY suitable for standard beds and box spring beds. Under no circumstances suitable for waterbeds, senior beds or bunk beds.

Use ONLY replacement parts recommended by the manufacturer. Discontinue use if parts are damaged, broken or missing.

The length of the mattress cannot exceed 245CM (96.5"), and the shortest cannot be less than 165CM (65").

When in the locked position or when placed in the fitted position, touches the side of the mattress.

This bed guard should be periodically checked for its general condition with particular reference to the security of any locking mechanism and/or hinges that are used on the product.

This bed guard should not be used on a sleeping surface that is more than 600 mm (24 inch) from the floor.

WARNING To prevent the risk of strangulation it is essential to ensure that when the bed guard is fitted into position, there is a gap of at least 250 mm (10 inch), between each end of the bed and the corresponding end of the bed guard.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

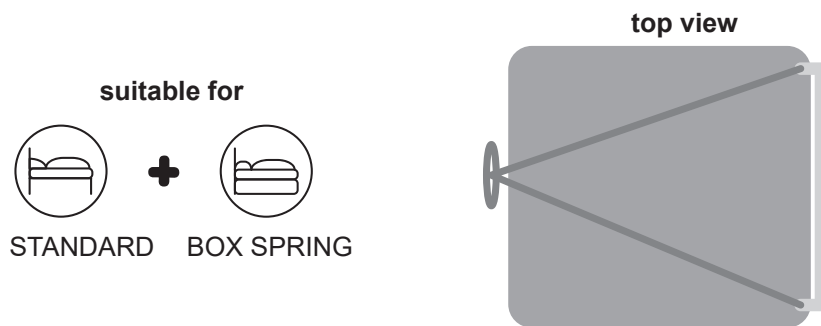
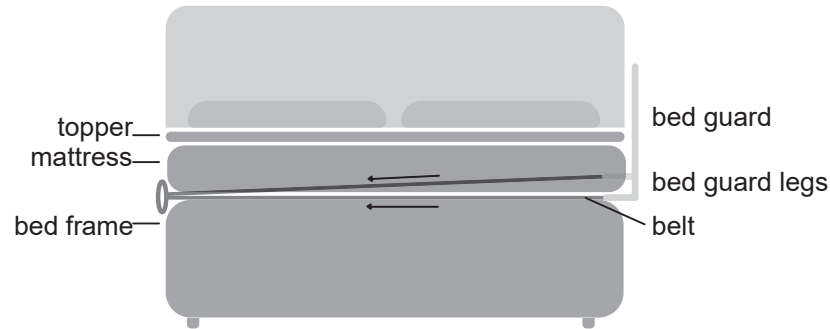
1. Do not bleach.
2. Wash by hand. Use household soap or detergent with water to wipe the dirty place.
3. Do not store or use the playpen in places with extremely high or extremely low temperatures or high humidity and always ensure adequate ventilation.

Usage of bed frame:

- 1) Hold the two legs under the mattress
- 2) Tighten the strap along the bottom of the mattress (in the form of a "V")
- 3) Fix the disc on the opposite side as shown



Return / Damage Claim Instructions

-  **DO NOT discard the box / original packaging.**
