A quarter (23%) say they have radically reimagined the space in their homes, or plan to in the future, to accommodate their changing needs. Nearly half (47%) of renters consider their current home their forever home and even more (88%) see their home as their sanctuary.

To help inspire renters to refresh their space, [Gill Baker, Head of Decor at B&Q](#) has shared a selection of easy DIY hacks and decor solutions that allow renters to upgrade their space with minimal fuss and maximum impact starting from just £4.38.

Gill Baker says: "One of the biggest misconceptions about renting is that you can't make a space truly feel like your own. With a few simple tweaks, like adding removable wallpaper, leaning artwork instead of drilling, or investing in statement furniture, you can create a home that reflects your personality. The key is to focus on what you can do (with permission) rather than what you can't do and choosing clever, temporary solutions that add character without leaving a trace. Of course, if you want to make bigger changes to your home, it's always advisable to seek the permission of your landlord. Our [The Way We Live Now 2025 report](#) found that 94% of requests are approved by landlords – it can be a win-win if they think a tenant will improve their home."


Tension Rods: A Versatile, Drill Free, Curtain Solution
